2. **Adjunct Faculty Member:** Associates of the AFAM program who are not full-time employees of the University, but who teach AFAM core, cross-listed, or “meets with” courses.¹
3. **Friend of AFAM:** Supporters of the AFAM program who are not currently active in AFAM teaching, research, or service, but who wish to be identified with AFAM’s mission.
