

## Journey Through THIG

Please follow the steps below utilizing the THIG CD-ROM.

Once you click on the shape of South Carolina on the introductory screen, an explanation page showing how to navigate the CD-ROM will appear.

Click on "Continue."

Begin at the circle in the "12:00" position on the main frame that will appear. This module contains information about the role that South Carolina played in the Civil War. Work your way through the module and place your mouse on the words written in white. These are called "roll-overs" and contain additional information.

Click on "Go to Blockade."

Click on "Go to "Blockade Runners."

Click on "Blockade Runner Animation." Note that you will need to reset the animation after each port that you visit.

Click on "Go to Development of the Hunley."

Click on "Hunley Animation." This animation may take a moment or two to load. Click on "Return to the Hunley" once you have viewed the animation.

Click on "Go to Mobile."

Click on "Animation of Hunley Practicing." After viewing the animation click "Back," go forward one frame and click on "Go to Mobile to Charleston."

Click on "Charleston Field Trip." Click on the magnifying glass and take the virtual field trip. Click on the smaller magnifying glass to take a virtual field trip of the Battery Park area of Charleston.

Click back three frames when you are done taking the field trip. Continue forward in this module.

Click on "Hunley Practicing with the Chicora." Click "Back" when you are finished viewing the animation.

Click on "Go to Mount Pleasant."

Click on "Go to Sullivan's Island."

Click on "Go to The Attack."

Click on "Weather History." Select a location. When you are finished viewing information about the weather, click on "Back to the Attack."

Click on "Attack Animation." Click on "Return to the Attack" once you have viewed the animation.

Click on "Go to Hunley Recovery." Click to view the forward hatch. Click to view the connecting nut and bolt. Click to view the artifacts.

Click on "Continue to Shipwreck Game." Read the direction frames and then try your skill at locating the shipwrecks that occurred in the vicinity of the Charleston Harbor during the Civil War.

When you finish playing the Shipwreck Game, click on the "Main" propeller found in the upper left corner of the screen.

Congratulations! You have successfully navigated THIG! You may exit the CD-ROM by clicking on the "Exit" propeller located in the lower right corner of the screen.
