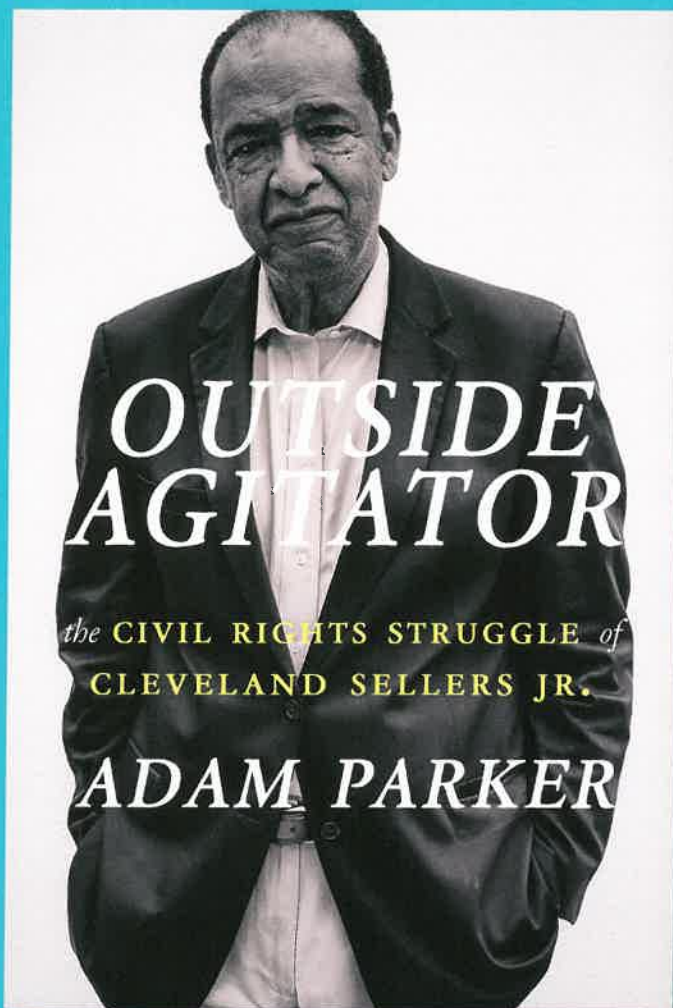

South Carolina civil rights pioneer Cleveland Sellers will share his journey from a 15-year-old organizing a small-town lunch counter sit-in to his false imprisonment for the Orangeburg Massacre and his national leadership with the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee. Hear his personal stories about icons such as Stokely Carmichael, Martin Luther King Jr. and Malcolm X and learn how the former USC professor's leadership in African-American studies transformed the teaching of black history.
